

Don't Worry About Missing Calls With. . .

Call Forwarding

Let Your Calls Follow You To Another Number.

How it works:

You can program your calls to ring at another number. Each time a call is forwarded, your phone will make one short ring. It can still be used to make outgoing calls.

To “turn on” the Service:

1. Lift the handset and listen for the dial tone.
2. Press ***** **7** **2** (On a rotary phone, dial 1172.)
3. Listen for the dial tone.
4. Dial the number where you want your calls forwarded.
5. When the phone is answered, your Call Forwarding is in effect.

If the line is busy, or there's no answer:

6. Hang up.
7. Within two minutes, repeat steps 1–4 above. You'll hear a confirmation tone, to let you know your Call Forwarding is now working.

To “turn off” the Service:

1. Lift the handset and listen for a dial tone.
2. Press ***** **7** **3** (On a rotary phone, dial 1173.)
3. Listen for the confirmation tone, then hang up. Your Call Forwarding is now “off,” and calls will ring normally on your phone.

To change the “forward to” number:

1. Turn off Call Forwarding.
2. Repeat steps 1–5 above to turn on Call Forwarding, entering the new “forward-to” number.
